#### WHAT YOU CAN COMPOST WITH LEXSORT

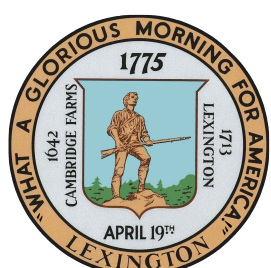
##### YES

- ✓ Fruit and vegetables, peelings, pits, seeds, scraps
- ✓ Eggshells and nutshells
- ✓ Rice, pasta, bread, pastries, cookies, cereal
- ✓ Coffee grounds & filters, teabags
- ✓ Cut or dry flowers
- ✓ Meat, seafood, bones; fats, grease, oils
- ✓ Food-soiled: paper napkins, paper towels, paper bags, newspaper
- ✓ Wooden: coffee stirrers, toothpicks, skewers, popsicle sticks
- ✓ Wine corks (*real cork*, not plastic)
- ✓ *BioBag* brand bags or other *certified compostable* bags (BPI, CMA, TUV)
- ✓ Cheese, yogurt, and other dairy

##### NO

- ✗ Plastic bags and plastic-coated paper
- ✗ Produce stickers, twist ties, rubber bands
- ✗ Pizza boxes (*recycle curbside*)
- ✗ Yard waste (*recycle curbside, following Town's collection calendar, or at the Hartwell Ave. facility*)
